

Articulation Agreement Between
University of New England's (UNE) College of Professional Studies
UNE Online Post-Baccalaureate Pre-Health Program
UNE Online Master of Biomedical Science
and
UNE Westbrook College of Health Professions Master of Science, Physician Assistant

I. Eligibility Criteria:

- a. To qualify for admission consideration under this agreement, UNE Online Pre-Health Program students must:
 - i. Achieve a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher in their UNE Online Pre-Health Program coursework in either the UNE PBPH or UNE MBS Program
 - ii. Earned 24 credits in the PBPH program or confer the MBS degree (30 graduate credits)
 - iii. Achieve a cumulative BCP GPA of 3.0 on the CASPA application.
 - iv. Submit the completed CAPSA application by September 1 of the application cycle and notify the graduate admissions department at gradadmissions@une.edu and the CPS Prehealth Advising Team at cpsprehealthadvising@une.edu.
 - v. Apply to only one professional health program at the University of New England in a given admissions cycle.
 - vi. Fulfill all other WCHP-PA application requirements, including submission of a complete application, recommendation letters, and any additional assessments or interviews as required.
